

## **DCBA SEEKING NEW BOARD MEMBERS**

The Dane County Bicycle Association (DCBA) is recruiting candidates for current and future openings on its board of directors. DCBA is a foundation that provides about \$10,000 in annual grant funding for projects to support bicycle education, usage and advocacy. Examples of DCBA grants in past years include seed money for new organizations such as the Bicycle Federation of Wisconsin, support for special projects by bicycle clubs, and funds for bicycle education programs conducted by schools and community groups.

DCBA consists of a 7-member board that oversees the foundation's investments and reviews and decides on grant applications submitted from around Wisconsin. The foundation's assets are the result of the sale of the former Yellow Jersey Cooperative in the mid-1970's.

Board members generally meet twice a year - - in February to hold an annual business meeting and determine which grant proposals will be funded, and again in October to plan the grant solicitation process for the upcoming year.

Members should be interested in bicycling, be available to attend the February and October meetings in Madison, and be willing and able to review and discuss the grant applications annually submitted to DCBA. Other special skills often helpful to board members include marketing, accounting, investment management and meeting facilitation.
